- Theme: Johnny Appleseed/Apples
- Math: Read the "Math News" parent letter and look over any math problem set papers that your child brings home. Go over again at home anything they might have missed or had trouble understanding.
- Writing: Learning what writing is and how to write a simple "I like" or "I love" story. (sentence)
- Social Studies: Playing together. Look for our Scholastic social studies weekly reader, <u>Let's Find Out</u>, in your child's folder, and read and go over with your child at home. Thank you! And, we'll be reading Johnny Appleseed books.
- Science: Color mixing experiment.
